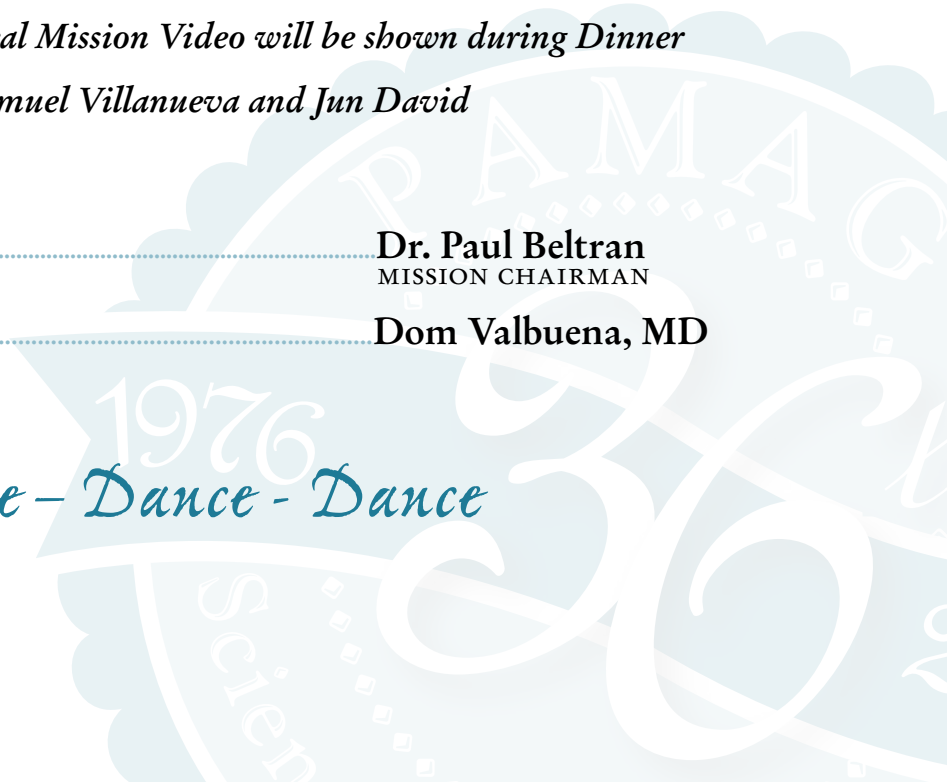

As a measure of my performance during my first year as President, I went back to my incoming President's Address of last year's PAMAG Ball. I outlined 2 goals: 1. To assure that the PAMAG Annual CME and Ball continue to be successful and 2. To do a good job as keeper of what has been good about PAMAG namely; the medical mission to the Philippines and the support of scholars in the Share a Child Movement. A third goal which I did not write in my last year's Presidential address but I mentioned during my speech last year is the recruitment of new members, both the inactive and the really new members to PAMAG. The 36th Annual PAMAG CME and Ball will show whether I have a measure of success in the third goal. The first goal was definitely achieved with the successful 35th PAMAG ANNUAL CME AND BALL in Stone Mountain, Georgia last year. And also by the upcoming 36th Annual PAMAG CME and Ball, thanks to Doctors' Vic and Grace Bautista, Doctor Dom and Gayle Valbuena and Dr. Sam and Linda Torres. The second goal was achieved through the medical mission to Puerto Princesa, Palawan, Philippines on January 24 to 28, 2011. The sheer number of volunteers (87) that went on this mission who brought with them their dedication to provide the citizens there with their healthcare skills, their collected materiel and even their money led to the performance of 259 varied surgical cases, the care of over 6,000 medical, pediatric and dental patients. The leadership abilities of my wife Cora had a lot to do with the success of the medical mission there. Even though her hometown is 5 hours away from Puerto Princesa, her family's connections with the movers and shakers of Puerto Princesa city and of her home province of Palawan certainly had a lot to do with the enthusiastic cooperation we found with our local partners. The video that will be shown during dinner at the Annual Ball produced so well by Jun David will highlight this large scale humanitarian service given to the citizens of Puerto Princesa city and the province of Palawan. The other half of the humanitarian face of PAMAG, the endowment of financial and material assistance to the scholars of the Share a Child Movement in Cebu continues to be successful mainly due to the steadfast leadership of Doctors Livia and Halbert Capuy. The PAMAG proceeds of the sale of the medical mission DVD that will be shown at the Ball is divided equally between the 2013 PAMAG Medical Mission Fund and the Share a Child Movement Scholar Fund.

It is indeed with a feeling of pride and joy that I am mentioning these things.

Furthering the civic mindedness of PAMAG is the work of Drs. Marilyn and Paul Beltran. Through their efforts, the partnership with Smile Train was again demonstrated during the medical mission in Puerto Princesa, Palawan. Paul will be giving a report on this vital and life changing partnership during the Annual Ball. The plans to have a PAMAG medical mission program right here in Georgia are in its infancy. If the numerous details and hurdles are successfully dealt with, then this plan will place PAMAG as a highly visible service organization locally, in our State of Georgia.

Organizations come and go. It is a fact of life. With PAMAG, there is now a new way to maintain its longevity. It is no longer dependent solely on the important job of recruiting new members, both really new members and inactive members. PAMAG will endure because it has a humanitarian face, which therefore invigorates its members and is a natural draw for others to take interest in PAMAG and for a number of such people to develop within them a push to join PAMAG. Matamang Salamat! (Thanks in the dialect of Palawan).

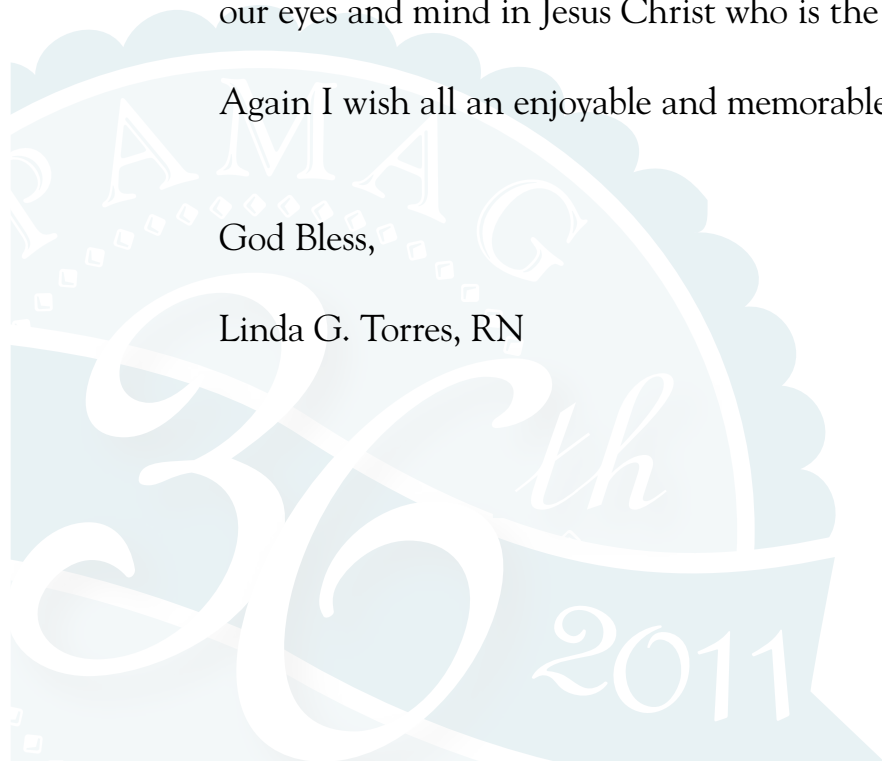
Let us keep the fervor, engagement, mentoring and spirit of cooperation to make PAMAG a strong and durable organization.

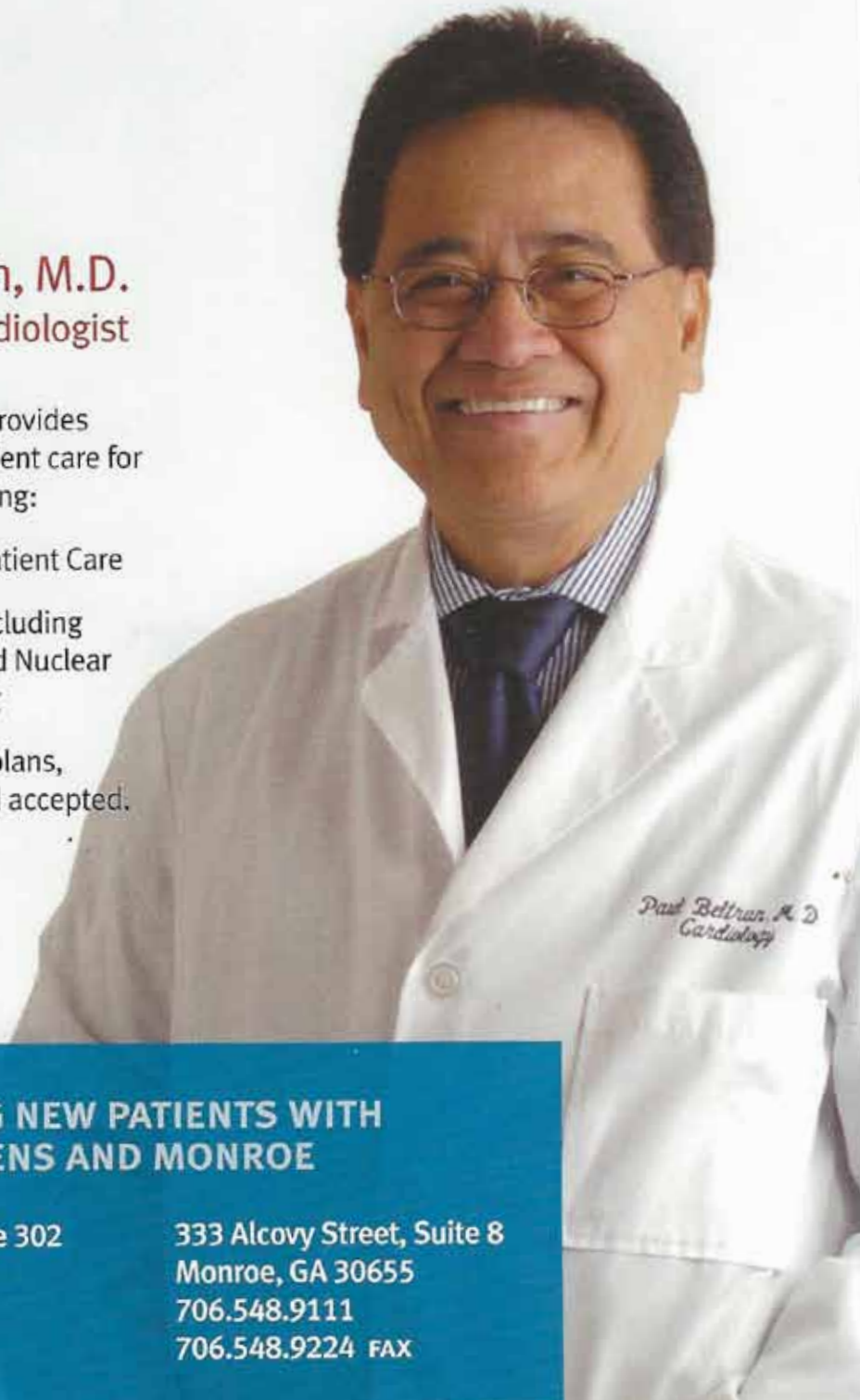
